1. In Mark 8:27-29 Jesus asks His disciples who people think He is. Who do people say that Jesus is today? Is important for us to understand what the people in our culture believe about Jesus? Why or why not?
2. Peter answers Jesus' question for himself by stating that Jesus is the Christ (or the Messiah). What is significant about calling Jesus the Christ or the Messiah? How do people respond to the idea of Jesus being the Christ?
3. Ronnie listed several world religions who all hold Jesus in high regard. Is holding Jesus in high regard enough? Why is it important to be accurate about who Jesus really is and what He really did?
4. The whole story of Jesus is summarized in these six words: Manger, Cross, Empty Tomb, Clouds, Fire, Trumpet. Why is each essential in the account of the person of Jesus?
5. Philippians 2:6-8 shows Jesus' attitude about Himself and us. How does this attitude make Him unique from other gods? How does it feel for you to live for and serve this kind of God and Savior?
6. Most of us were taught as children that if you don't have enough to share with the whole class then don't share it at all. What is the fault of using this thinking in our lives as servants? What does it look like to do for the one what we wish we could do for everyone?
